That is why when I call or when some of you call me, and I hear an MBG voice, my heart sings. But God is good. His love joins us together. His love also sustains our hope that better times will soon be upon us. I pray... I believe... I trust...

About our MBG Raffle that was supposed to have taken place during the National Convention we had planned for last July 22, 2021 to celebrate our Diamond Jubilee, **please take note of the following adjustments from our Raffle Committee (Empie Bautista, Nettie Aggabao, Polly Baquiran) that we are implementing:**

- Date of Raffle July 22, 2022 (Friday)... we keep the MBG feastday July 22, but next year. Should pandemic concerns still be present by then, we shall hold our Raffle face to face at Pius XII Catholic Center, and at the same time to be live streamed online. Time of Raffle will be announced in June 2022.
- 2. Timeline of Raffle Ticket Redistribution & Payment
 - July 22, 2021 start of re-distribution of tickets already in the hands of Arch/Diocesan/Apostolic Vicariate/Prelature/MOP Council Presidents (if these have not yet been distributed)
 - May 31, 2022 submission of raffle ticket stubs at Pius XII Catholic Center (office of Amb. De Villa c/o Alice Saguid). This is also the cut-off period for remittance of payments either personally at our Pius office to Alice or deposit at BDO Savings Account of Mother Butler Guild Account Number 000220162751. If payment is through the latter, kindly email photo of deposit slip (amb.htv@i-manila.com.ph) or send photo of deposit slip via Messenger to Alice Saguid (09218267801).
- 3. June 1–July 15, 2022 Raffle Committee will go to Pius XII Catholic Center to double check ticket stubs, match these with payments received, and drop ticket stubs inside the tambiolo.

- 4. Lost Tickets considering that all tickets have been distributed, the following rules on lost tickets shall be followed:
 - Only stubs of paid tickets will be placed inside the tambiolo and eligible to win.
 - For tickets that have been lost but have been paid for, MBG Parish Unit President is to prepare ¼ sheet of bond paper with the following information:

 - Signature over printed name of MBG Arch/Diocesan /Apost.Vicariate /Prelature/ MOP Council President
 - Submit this duly accomplished ¼ sheet of bond paper to the MBG National office.
 <u>Note:</u>
 - a) Lost but paid tickets will be considered and eligible to win provided the above provisions are followed.
 - b) Since the MBG Coordinator/Council President/Parish Unit President have a record of the tickets distributed to them, it will not be difficult to track lost tickets.
 - c) Lost tickets that cannot be accounted for are considered as sold.
